Project Management

The Children's Ministry Management Committee of the Diocese of Muhabura, together with leaders of other Church denominations and community leaders have appointed a Board of Directors which has the power to manage the project. The Board includes members of the Diocesan Board of Education, members of local government, and is also represented by the office of the Magistrate and Probation Services (who are legally responsible for abandoned and destitute children).

Whilst the project is a community and interdenominational project, the foundation body is the Church of Uganda and it is being run as a Christian enterprise. The children in the care of the project will be brought up with Christian values and will be exposed to Christian teaching where appropriate, unless there is clear evidence that they come from another religious background.
